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Mrs. Frank took her class to the zoo.

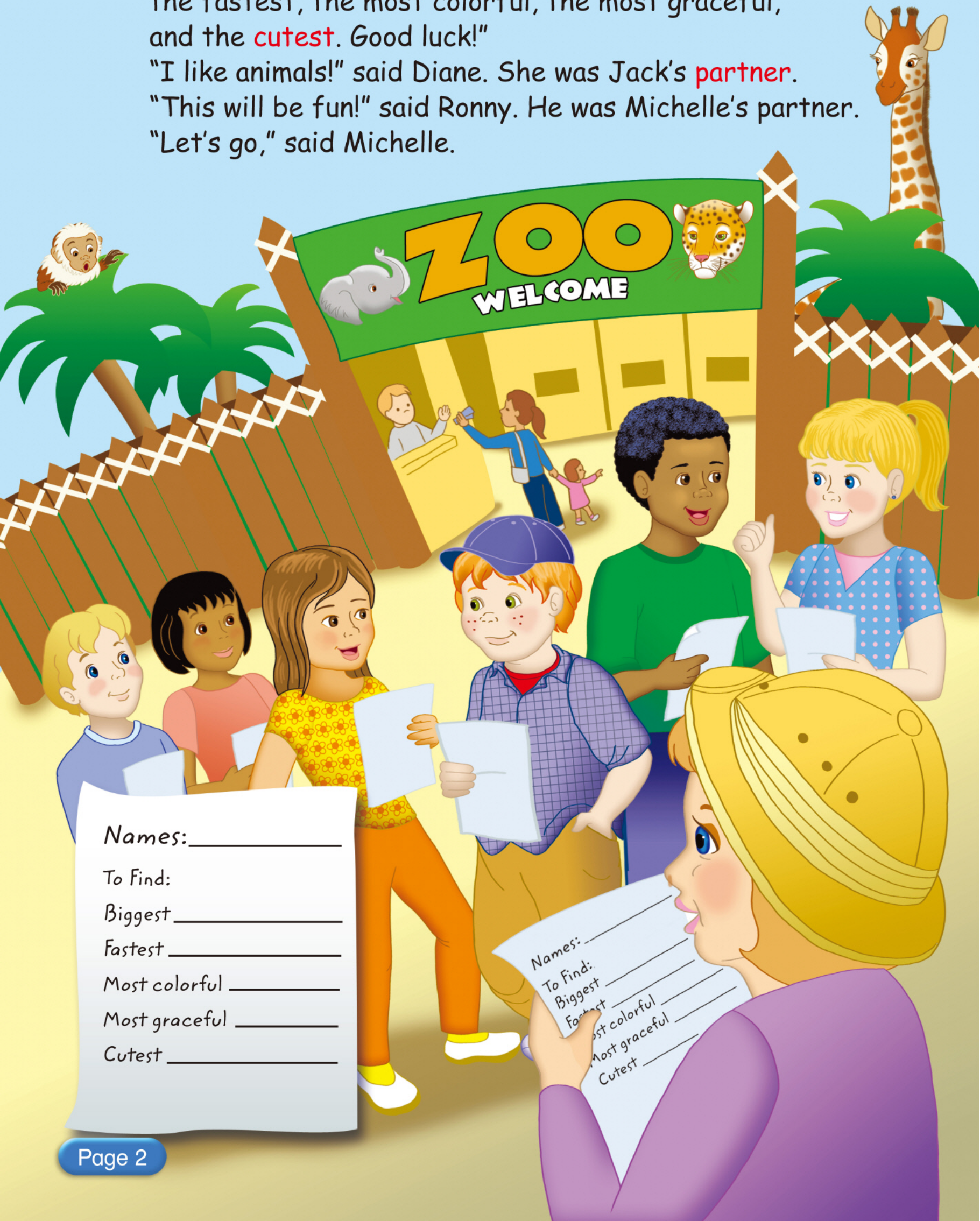
"Look at the **list**," she said.

"Wow. Too bad. We're not looking for the least colorful animal," said Michelle.

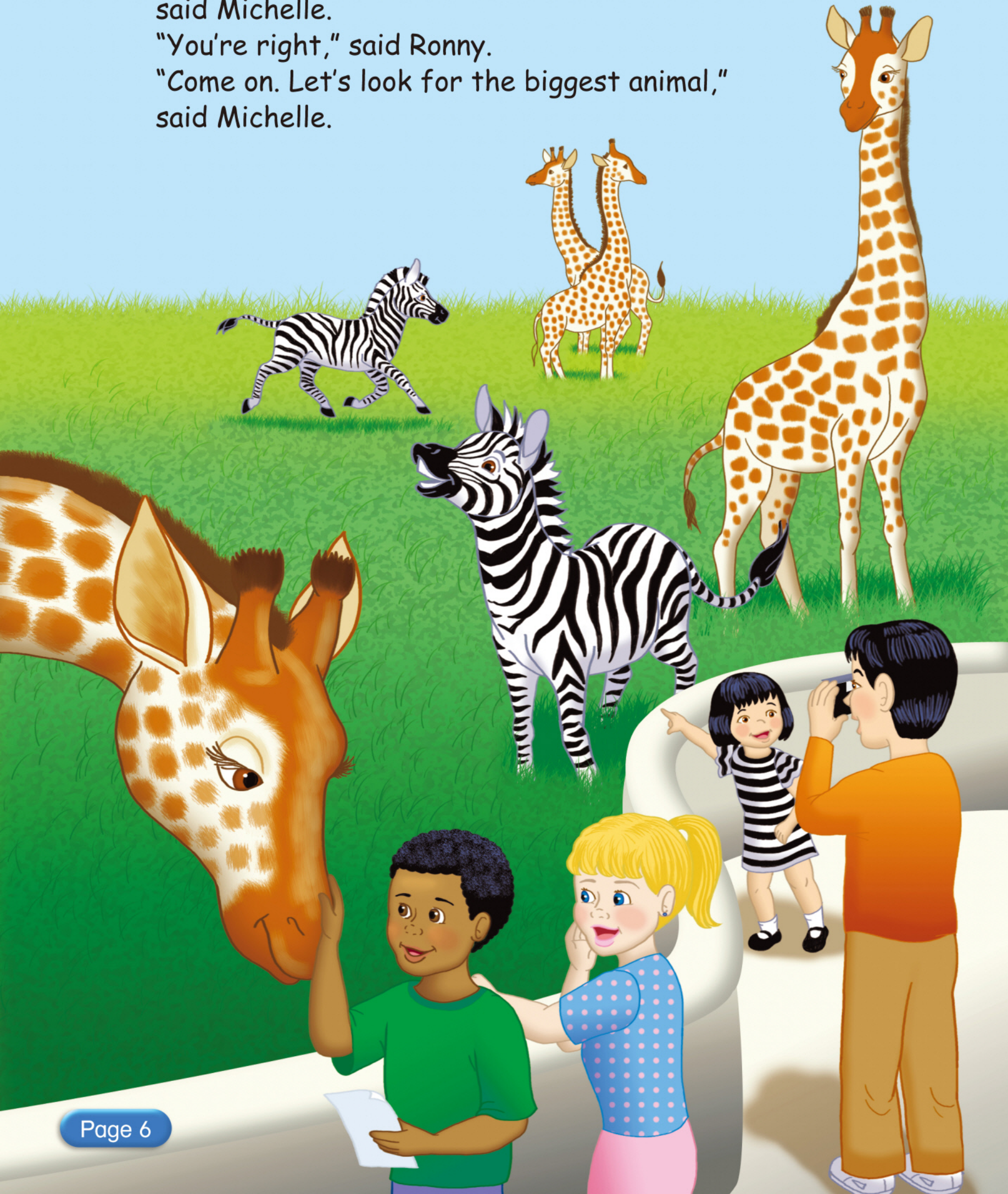
"Look," said Michelle. "The zebra is more graceful than the giraffe."
